# **The Blessing of Waiting**

Christmas is one of my favorite seasons of the year. This year, I am so pleased to be here with you as we celebrate the birthday of our Lord. I love all the wonderful events that come with the season, the special programs and all the other church activities and services.

This year, I'm looking forward to our special Christmas Eve service. I've heard such wonderful things about it. I am also excited about the Karen special Christmas Eve activities and Christmas morning worship service.

Much of what we call the Christmas season really takes place during Advent. Advent, which comes from the Latin word, "coming" begins on Sunday, December 3rd and ends on Christmas Eve.

Traditionally, in the Christian church, it has been a time of waiting for the - celebration of the birth of Jesus and for the second coming of Jesus.

Since "Waiting" is at the heart of Advent, I want to share a few thoughts with you about the blessing that waiting can be in our lives. As we study the Scriptures, we find that waiting was always an important part of the lives of God's people down through Church History. It was an integral part of Israel's history as the Jewish people waited for their Messiah. In the New Testament, an emphasis on waiting was also a part of the teaching that Jesus gave His disciples and the writers of the New Testament gave the early church.

In our modern lives, waiting is an important part of our everyday life. It heightens our sense of expectation and pleasure as we wait for special events. Conversely, it can mean waiting for a crucial doctor's report, waiting for the answer to a very important question or waiting for the news about a loved one or friend. Waiting means many things to each of us, sometimes joyful and sometimes fearful.

However, the waiting I am suggesting to be part of our Advent experience, is waiting for God to show us what to do in our everyday lives. It is a waiting that comes through prayer and meditation such as Jesus must have experienced in His prayer times with the Father. With that kind of waiting comes an excitement, expectation and hope that is hard to explain but is so very real. As I think about that kind of waiting I am reminded of the excitement I feel at the theater waiting for the curtain to go up, wondering how the plot will unfold or what the characters in the play will be like. Then the lights begin to dim, a hush comes over the audience, the curtain goes up and the play begins.

I think a similar thing takes place when waiting on God. A time comes when "the curtain goes up" on God showing us His will and as the plot of God's will unfolds, there comes with it a confidence that we are now ready to do His will and that the waiting was all part of the preparation.

As the Old Testament Prophet Isaiah wrote, "They that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength. They shall mount up with wings as eagles. They shall run and not be weary. They shall walk and not faint."

May the blessings of Advent and Christmas be yours,
