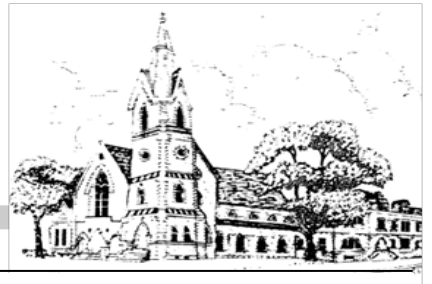

Exciting Changes Ahead!

During our Annual Meeting in January 2018 it was agreed that surplus funds from 2017 would be put towards the purchase of a new projection system for the Sanctuary. TABERNACLE BAPTIST CHURCH OF UTICA

A Brief Summary of Its History and Buildings

- September 12, 1801** Twenty-two Welsh immigrants form the First (Welsh) Baptist Church of the village of Utica. This congregation erects a house of worship at what is now the corner of Hotel and Oriskany Streets. (In 1822, this building is moved to Broadway near Liberty Street.)
- October 7, 1819** The First Baptist Church votes to dismiss from its membership seventeen English-speakers for the purpose of organizing an English language Baptist congregation.
- February 21, 1820** This English language congregation is incorporated as *The Second Baptist Church of the Village of Utica*. A lot is purchased on the north side of Broad Street where the new church's first house of worship is erected. The congregation is commonly called *The Broad Street Baptist Church*.
- March 21, 1838** Eleven individuals are dismissed from the membership of the Second Baptist Church to form the Bethel Baptist Church of Utica. In 1847 this congregation purchases the Second Presbyterian Building on Bleecker Street. Thereafter it is commonly known as *The Bleecker Street Baptist Church*. In 1888 the Bleecker Street Church constructs a new edifice at the corner of Rutgers and West Streets and assumes the name, *Park Baptist Church*.
- June 21, 1847** The congregation decides to replace its inadequate original facilities. By August, the first building is razed and soon a new building is constructed on the same site.
- September 28, 1848** The second church building, with seating capacity of 450, is dedicated. The new building contains a baptistry. Previously, baptisms had occurred outdoors, typically in the Mohawk River.
- June, 1864** The congregation vacates its house of worship. Worship services are conducted in the United States Court Room in City Hall.
- October 11, 1864** The congregation decides to change its name to *The Tabernacle Baptist Church*. At this meeting it is reported that John Thorn has given the church a lot on Hopper Street (near the southern suburbs of the city) for the construction of a new building. Architect G.S. Meacham of Boston is hired to design the new edifice.
- August 3, 1865** The cornerstone of the present sanctuary building is laid.
- September 13, 1886** The new edifice is dedicated. The building is constructed of local red sandstone, quarried from the South Woods. The tower spire rises 133 feet. The sanctuary seats 500. The interior is "ornamented in the medieval style with stencil work in primitive colors, upon rich ground shades."
- 1888** The sanctuary floor is slanted to its present incline and the rear wall is moved backward to allow for greater seating capacity in the sanctuary.
- 1889** Mrs. John Thorn purchases an adjacent lot immediately south of the church building. A "chapel" building is erected at the rear of the sanctuary. Doors to this new structure are cut at the rear of the sanctuary, a baptistry is added, and new windows are installed.
- 1898** Work begins on the remodeling of the sanctuary. Electricity is introduced, replacing the old gas lighting system used throughout the building.

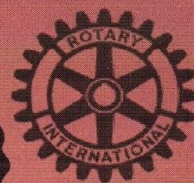
