

The Rev. James M. Dick, retired American Baptist Pastor, passed on from this life to the next on September 6; at the age of 92. Rev. Dick served in the American Baptist Publication Society and pastored churches in Alfred and Pittsford, NY; Waukesha, WI; and Germantown, PA. He served as interim minister in Flemington, NJ and Whitesboro. Rev. Dick also served in World War II. He became a member of Tabernacle Baptist Church on August 30, 1992 and was very active in the church, serving in many capacities including teacher of the Adult Sunday School class and preacher on occasions when the pastor was away. He was known for his love of mentoring younger ministers and serving in any capacity he was needed. He is survived by a son and daughter. Please keep his family in your prayers.


Each year the youth select a mission project to support by raising money to present during the convention. This year's mission project is:

Poultry for Protein in South Africa




- \$100 will provide an incubator.


