In days to come the mountain of the LORD's house will be established as the highest of the mountains, and will be raised above the hills;all the nations will stream to it.

> Many peoples will come and say, "Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, the house of the God of Jacob; that he may teach us his ways and that we may walk in his paths.

> > Come, let us walk in the light of the LORD!

"Now we ask you, brothers and sisters, to acknowledge those work hard among you, who care for you in the Lord and who admonish you. Hold them in the highest regard in love because of their work."

1 Thessalonians 5:12-13

In this passage, Paul instructs the church to value and acknowledge leaders of the church as messengers of Christ. Beginning in the mid-1930s, American Baptist congregations broadened their provision to include a Christmas gift to retired and elderly ministers. Since 1977, American Baptists have collected the Retired Ministers and Missionaries Offering (RMMO) to make this ministry to God's retired servants possible. 
