Lenten and Easter greetings to you all!

We are blessed to have some signs of spring accompanying us in this latter part of Lent this year. For example, a few green shoots have pushed up through the soil around the parsonage. We await the day when exactly what they are will be revealed!

TBC recently received the piece of art pictured here. "The Crucifixion" is by Henry Coupe, a noted local artist and former art teacher. Mr. Coupe's wife donated her late husband's work, and we will display it on Maundy Thursday when we gather for a meal and a service beginning at 6 p.m.


Although the painting is a bit abstract, there is no question of what it reveals: Christ's execution on a cross. The Christ figure is central, but he is not alone in the scene. Lacking Coupe's commentary on the painting, we are free to consider who the other figures represent. Might the center-left figure be Judas? He stands to the fore clutching something—potentially, a bag of silver coins. According to Matthew 27:3-

6, Judas died by suicide before Jesus' crucifixion. Having heard that Jesus was condemned, Judas returned the silver to the authorities who had paid him to betray Jesus. But, turning over the money was not enough to salve his conscience. He put an end to his sense of guilt by ending his life.

Judas missed that first Easter morning. Sure, he missed watching Jesus carry the cross and being beaten. He missed the sight of the one who had shown him nothing but love dying a shameful criminal's death.

But, Judas also missed the opportunity for forgiveness in this life. Other disciples messed up big time, too. Take Peter's 3-round denial of Jesus, for example. But, Peter stuck around past those denials and was one of the first to go to the empty tomb. Peter, along with the rest of the disciples, would see the risen Christ revealed to them as resurrected.

What was the difference in Judas' understanding of unfaithfulness and that of Peter? When Judas was on his way to punish himself in the cruelest way, what could a fellow disciple have said to give him hope?



All those statements and more were true then and are true for us today. We stand in the foreground waiting to remember the Last Supper, Jesus' crucifixion, and the resurrection. Come and stand with us. Picture yourself there with whatever you bring.

It's not over yet! You made a mistake, but there is forgiveness! God has yet more to reveal to us about this Christ!


Senior Luncheon at Red Lobster


