Back in the office after the ABC-USA Mission Summit by the Sea in Virginia, I am happy to announce that the 100-day countdown to TBC's 200th Anniversary Jubilee has begun! The Summit provided many opportunities to share about the delightful ways God is blessing us here in Utica. TBC is a shining light for many congregations who, like us, have navigated many transitions over the generations.

In these last 100 days of TBC's 199th year, we will do many of the things that brought life here in the last 2 centuries. Here are a few highlights:

Making Music – Beginning Sunday, July 7, during the 2nd hour (roughly 11:15-12:30), we will offer a multi-generational music class in the East Room. Whether you are starting from scratch or read, sing, and/or play an instrument well, come and make music with us. We hope to foster an intergenerational musical offering for the Jubilee.

Nurturing Faith – TBC's young adult group, TBC Christian Endeavor, will host a Karen Bible study July 2-4, from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. Three pastors from Burma will visit us and teach.

Worshiping – Middle-school and senior-high students will remain in the English service this summer, and we will be experimenting with some ancient and some non-traditional pieces in worship to engage them. Curious what that will look like? I am, too! Let's see what God will do!

Sending Missionaries – First, TBC Christian Endeavor is responding to an invitation from Cuba Baptist Church in Cuba, NY, to come on July 14th and share in worship in song and about Karen history and what life is like as a Karen Christian in Utica. Second, a group of our teenagers and adults will participate in the ABC-NYS Mission Team to Community Ministries in Niagara Falls on July 25-28. Pray for us! We hope to give a report in worship in August.

Doing Missions and Fostering Fellowship Here – Volunteers are needed to paint Thorn Chapel between July 5th and July 20th. Paint and equipment will be available from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday-Thursday and 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturday, July 13th and 20th. Give an hour or a whole day! Bring your own paintbrush and/or roller if you have a favorite! Contact Pastor Debbie for more information. Thanks to those who gave their input on paint colors!
