

Church School Picnic at Sherrillbrook Town Park







An Unforgettable Weekend!



Sanctuary Projection Update

As previously mentioned in our April Visitor we are anxiously awaiting the arrival of our new Digital Screen projection system that was approved during our Annual Meeting in January 2018. The Stewardship Ministry and Worship and Witness teams were involved throughout in the process and approval of the purchase of the system.

The projection system will give us exciting flexibility allowing us to show videos and presentations from ABC-USA and presentations from incoming special guest speakers. It will also allow for special effects during music and dramatic presentations, as well as enable us to display Biblical Text, hymns, announcements and other information on the screens, which will be shown in dual languages (English and Karen) for easier interpretation.

The screens will be installed in the choir loft area towards the base of the organ pipes. The screens will hang on "trusses" which can be moved and re-arranged as needed to allow for additional flexibility of use.

We are anticipating the arrival of the screens any day now - and hope to have them installed and operational as soon as possible. Members of the congregation have expressed how excited they are that we will have this new technology available to enhance our worship experiences.

We would like to thank the Stewardship Ministry Team for their hard work and vision which has made this exciting change possible.

Dear Friends in Christ:

It is time again for our congregation to receive a very special offering. For many years, each June, Tabernacle Baptist Church has received the **One Great Hour of Sharing** (OGHS) offering. Through this special offering, we are given the opportunity to help our brothers and sisters in need around the world and participate in the many ministries that serve the hungry, the poor, the distressed and the refugees.

The offering theme this year is "More Than We Can Imagine" It is easy to feel overwhelmed when we look at all the areas of need in God's world: there is hunger, sickness, and injustice in so many communities. It is easy to feel that we are too small, too insignificant to make a difference, to believe that there's nothing we can do to help. We can feel trapped by hopelessness and fear that there is little we can do to make an impact.

But there is hope! Better yet: we are the hope!

For the Apostle Paul writes, "...by the power at work within us," God is able to "accomplish abundantly more than we can ask or imagined." (Ephesians 3:20)

As Christians, we know that God's dream for His people is not that we would strive to be separate, caring only for ourselves, God gave us community to practice love and compassion. We know that when we share our resources we find that there is enough for us all! We are all part of the same family whether we live in an agricultural community in Nicaragua or in a bustling urban city in the United States—we are all God's people.

Paul's letter to the Ephesians reminds us that we do not act alone. We act as a Church: A gathering of God's people still living into Paul's prayer that we be "rooted and established in love." (Ephesians 3:17b) Paul likens the Christians of Ephesus first to a well-rooted tree, and then to a well-built house. In both cases, the unseen cause of their stability will be the same: love. Love is to be the soil in which their life is to be rooted; love is to be the foundation on which their life is built."

As Christians, living into this loving legacy we act out of faith knowing that God is using our contributions in ways that we cannot foresee, multiplying blessings in ways we do not expect.

Will you be part of God's dream for the world? Will you accept the invitation to make a difference and see what God will do with our giving?




